Vote Check: Amendments Defeated to Protect Private Property Rights

WASHINGTON, D.C. – During the House Natural Resources Committee markup of the *Cascadia Marine Trail Study Act (H.R. 1641)* and the *North Country National Scenic Trail Route Adjustment Act (H.R. 481)*, Democrats voted against two amendments to protect Americans’ private property rights.

Rep. Broun of Georgia Amendment to HR 1641- Requiring Consent from Property Owners

H.R. 1641 would provide for a study of the Cascadia Marine Trail in Washington state to determine its eligibility to be designated a National Scenic Trail.

This amendment would require written consent from private property owners before the federal government could include their land in the study.

Rep. Bishop of Utah Amendment to H.R. 481 - Prohibiting "Buffer Zones"

H.R. 481 would authorize a re- route of the North Country National Scenic Trail to include existing hiking trails along Lake Superior’s north shore and in Superior National Forest and Chippewa National Forest.

This amendment would protect the rights of private property landowners adjacent to the trail by prohibiting the National Park Service from creating “buffer zones” outside of the National Park boundaries that would interfere with how private property owners use their lands.
